Fire safety instructions for residents of A-Kruunu properties:

Barbecue season

Generally speaking, the electric grill is always the safest option for grilling.

Open fire is prohibited on balconies, patios and residential yards. This means that you cannot use carbon, wood or disposable grills in these spots. Using gas grills on balconies is forbidden.

Gas grills can be used in row house and patio yards as long as you keep fire safety issues in mind.

When grilling, please be considerate of your neighbours since the smoke can easily reach neighbouring apartments and cause disruption. For this reason, the use of items like electric smokers is completely prohibited on balconies and residential yards.

Grilling in communal yards is only allowed in designated spots.

Users must know how to use their gas grill and carefully read the safety instructions before use. Make sure that you always store gas cylinders according to official regulations. It is forbidden to store gas cylinders and other flammable or dangerous substances in the communal storage spaces.

Candles and outdoor candles

It is prohibited to burn candles on a bookshelf, on electrical equipment or with flammable material close to them. Burn candles only on a noncombustible mat and never leave them unattended.

Children and pets should not be left unattended with burning candles.

Outdoor candles are not intended for balcony use and must not be burned on the porch or on covered patios either.

Take weather conditions into account when grilling and burning outdoor fires and candles. Windy weather might cause damage more easily.

Exercise extreme caution and follow the fire safety instructions when you're dealing with fire!
